## 1. Decisions of the Brother Superior General and his Council

#### 2.1 Nominations

The Brother Superior General, with the consent of his Council, appoints:

Brother Raymond DUCHARME, Director of the Scholasticate of Manila for one year.

## 2.2 Admission to perpetual profession

The Brother Superior General, with the consent of his Council, has admitted to perpetual profession:

- Brother Ghislain KOMBI, Congolese Brother of the District of Saint John Paul II (Central Africa)
