JEAN MARIE DE LA MENNAIS, A MAN FULL OF KINDNESS His words



18th

*I want to see my children full Of charity and understanding towards their brothers, that they excuse them rather than accuse them.

- May fraternal love reign between all the members of the Institute, particularly among those of the same community. That each one may rejoice at the joy of others, and suffer from their sorrows.

19th

- * I have the sweet confidence that none of you will stop being exemplary to all those with whom you meet. Above all, may a great charity and a perfect unity reign among you.
- Avoid carefully all that leads to quarrels, any words that are rude, bitter or full of reproach, any sign of impatience of rejection. Speak to one another with unalterable kindness.

20th

- * Each one has his own limitations: we see the ones of others but we must not forget our own and what the Apostle reminds us: « Carry one another's burden », and this way, we will fulfil the command of the Lord.
- Nobody is perfect. And the worse vice of all would be to expect from others more virtue than we ourselves posses.

21st

- * We must pity those who are doing evil and pray for them, but without letting ourselves being irritated by their ingratitude and injustice.
- Remain calm in all your actions, and kind in all your words, whatever mistakes may have been done against you: know how to suffer as a true Christian.

22na

Instead of unloading your work on others, strive to help one another, and commit yourself with the purest joy in the tasks that you find most difficult.

- To go to God and fulfil his mission, extend your mutual help to one another, avoiding all that hurts, all that divides the minds and hurts charity.

23rd

- * It is through your humility, your patience, your kindness that you will succeed. These are your arms.
- The brothers must be full of both gentleness and firmness, tolerating no disorder, but neither scolding or punishing students out of whim or bad temper.

24th

- * The small irritations of character that occur, I would say, every moment of the day, may cause many hurts. We need the **oil of charity** to heal them.
- Carry one another's burdens. In all occasions, act together with sincere charity, as would the members of the same body, of the same family.

25th

- * Remember well that we must carry one another's burdens, and that ours may be, without our knowing it, the heaviest to carry.
- Do not allow in your presence conversations that would hurt charity or alter the respect due to those in function of authority, even if they were to make mistakes... Who has never made a mistake? And what superior is totally exempt of errors?

26th

- * Do not attach any importance to the words that were reported to you, do not either hold a grudge against those who reported them. God will bless you for that little sacrifice you are making to please him.
- I recommend you anew to be full of compassion for your brothers, yes, for all of them without exception, even for those about whom you would have reason to complain.
