(To Miss Amable Chenu, 1821)

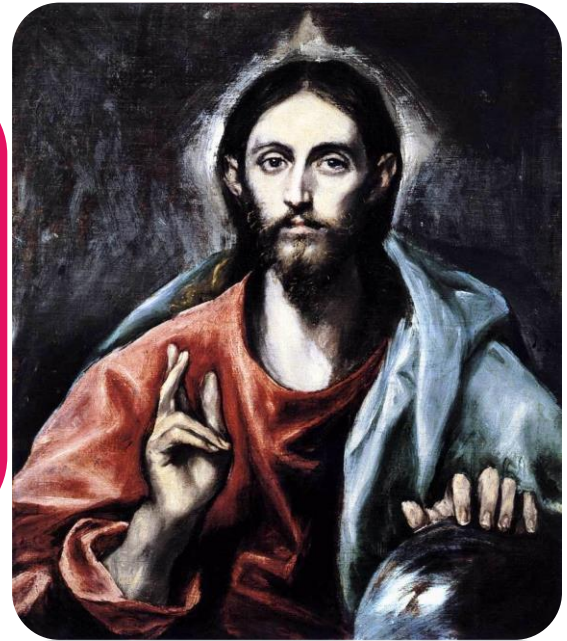
20 Easter

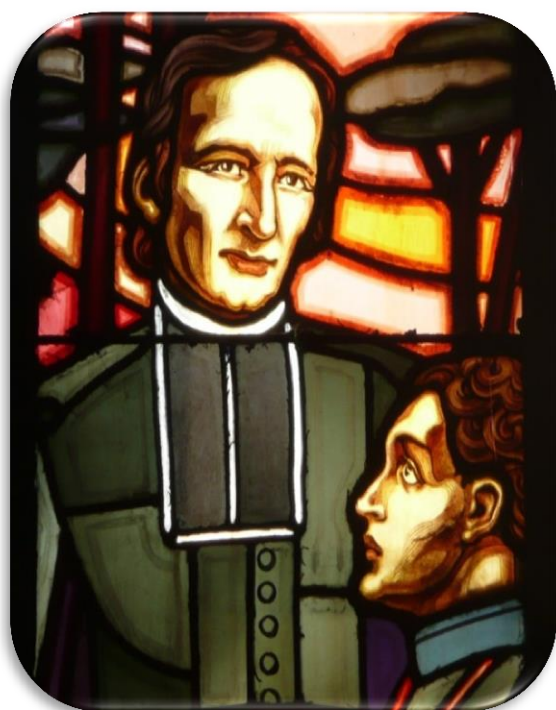


**Prayer for the beatification
