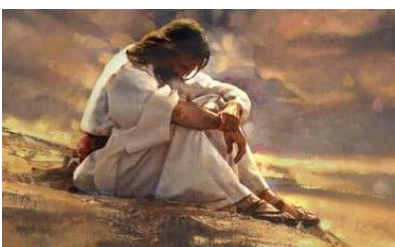

VII, 2247)

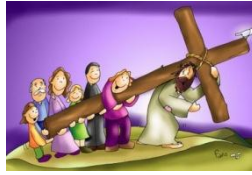

21: “Oh! If you knew how much he loves you! He wants you to be treated as He was treated, so that his entire passion is accomplished in you. He wishes that you be broken with the same blows, decorated with the same wounds, crowned with the same thorns, so that you may rise like him. He would wish that there be perfect conformity between the Master and the subjects.” (S VIII, 2378)



22: "A beautiful week! Let us die with Jesus Christ, Let us die on the cross, torn, mocked at and nailed. Yes, yes, we must die crucified!" (To Bruté, during the Holy Week, A I, 199)



23: "I also, my dear child, have a lot to suffer. I bless God, for we must bear that cross by which we were saved and thus fulfil in us what is lacking in the passion of Jesus Christ as St. Paul says." (A VI, 240)



24: "If you have difficulties, confide them only to God, and ask him to sanctify you by them. Recall often what Jesus Christ has suffered for humanity, and rejoice to have something to suffer for his love." (A VI, 245)

25: "Even the greatest saints were calumniated. Did Jesus Christ not suffer the same thing? That trial will be very

meritorious for you since it gives you a character of resemblance with our divine Saviour." (A VI, 314)

26: "Jesus Christ, our Saviour and our Model, from the hour of his birth up to his death on the cross, was never without pain. In order to share his glory, we must share his suffering." (A VI, 112 – 113)

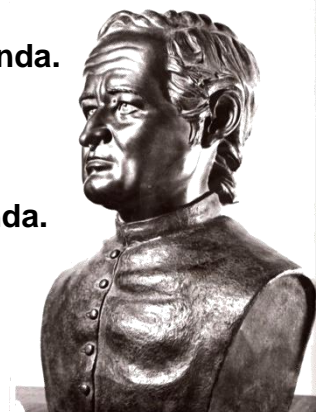


INTENTIONS
