ALLELUIA”**



18: “On this Easter festival, the most solemn of all the feasts of the year, the Church celebrates with songs of joy the great victory of Christ over sin and death, that is, his glorious resurrection.” (S. VI, 2031)



20: “Our spiritual resurrection ought to have the characteristics of the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ. However, Jesus Christ has risen to die no more: Christ has been raised from the dead and will never die again. Death has no power over him anymore.” (Roman. 6, 9) (S. VI, 2026)

19: “The resurrection of Christ is the pledge of ours, and since it is certain that he came out of the tomb glorious and triumphant, as he conquered death, we must hope that he will also take us away from its terrible hands, and at the end of time, he will give us back all that it takes away from us.” (S. IV, 1250 bis)

21: “The Resurrection of Jesus Christ is given to us in the highest degree of certainty, by the testimony of the apostles, by the conduct of the Jews, by all the events that followed the death of the Saviour, and that would be inexplicable or rather, which would have been quite impossible if his Resurrection was not real.” (S. VI, 1993)

22: “As the holy man Job says: *I know that my Redeemer lives, and that I will rise up at the last day; I know I will be clothed again with my skin, that I will see God in my own flesh, that I will see him with my own eyes; yes, it is the hope that I have, and it will always rest in my breast.*” (S. IV, 1252)



23: “Immediately, Mary Magdalene and her companions, in the transports of joy run, fly to Jerusalem; they are quick to tell the apostles all that was said to them, and all that they saw..” (S. VI, 2014)

24: “Like the apostles after witnessing the resurrection of Jesus Christ persevered to the end, and we convinced of the truth of this great miracle, let us hold fast in the ways of the Lord and let remain faithful to him forever.” (S. VI, 2024)



25: “When Jesus Christ our Lord appeared for the first time after his resurrection among his disciples, what did he say to them? Peace be with you. And these are also the words that I address to you, or rather the promise I make to you at this time when you are going to take your first commitments at the foot of the holy altar” (S. VII, 2377)

26: “In the same way that Jesus Christ after his resurrection preserves nothing of his earthly and mortal life, may everything be renewed and changed in you and, to make use of the expression of the Apostle, be a new creature in Jesus Christ.” (S. VI, 2028-2029)
