REFLECTION ON THE DEVOTION TO FATHER JEAN-MARIE DE LA MENNAIS

INTRODUCTION

Devotion to our Founder is a bit like the expression of love of sons for a parent; a love that creates a family spirit and togetherness and which unites the community of Mennaisian congregations scattered throughout the world. Through this devotion we can connect with the particularly fervent and heroic early days of our foundations.

Despite the care received, the disease has progressed and now the situation has become very serious. However, she faces the disease with great courage and a very strong faith, as testified by her last note that she sent to the Postulator.

"Thank you for your message. I am being looked after by the palliative care service and I alternate stays in their care with periods at home according to the various treatments they give me ... the disease has now spread and the chemotherapy sessions, the last of which was devastating difficult, have been abandoned definitively... to be able to consent (to God's will), to prepare myself and to accompany my husband and child... I receive the Body of Christ almost every day... the Rosary helps me to remain at peace... I thank the Lord so much for the graces he has bestowed upon me during my life... Thank you very much for your prayer."
