Atmosphere of the retreat:



We recall some elements that were important in Auray's retreat. The Motto: God Alone, the habit of the Brothers marked by the crucifix at the center of the chest, the Rule of Life, dictated and accepted by each one by the profession of obedience that closed the retreat

Three symbols are presented: FIC, Motto: GOD ALONE, Crucifix and Rule of Life. We pray with them in union with the Brothers and the entire Mennaisian Family spread throughout the world, asking the Lord to help us to be faithful to the intuitions of John Mary de la Mennais and Gabriel Deshayes, always seeking the ways of the Lord in today's world.

We thank the Lord for the two hundred years of existence of the Congregation. We remember a foundational moment, the Auray Retreat, held in September 1820 in Auray, in the Chapel of the Eternal Father. There the Brothers from the group of Jean Marie de la Mennais met for the first time with those of Father Gabriel Deshayes. They received the motto "God Alone", the name of Brothers of Christian Instruction, the religious habit and

the Rule of Life. There the first profession of the vow of obedience took place. Some historians say that while two groups of different aspiring and excited young men entered the retreat, it was a Congregation of the Brothers of Christian Instruction that came out.

Today we thank the Lord for the history, past and present, for all the wealth of love of God that this initiative of two people has taken all the places where the Mennaisian education continues to make sense today, hope and faith.

As we begin this time of prayer we listen to the Bicentennial Song.

The Auray's retreat, what changed? H.-C. Rulon (Petite histoire des Frères de l'Instruction chrétienne 1816-1860):

1°) The name and the Motto

From hereafter they will be called the **Brothers of Christian Instruction**

As for the motto "God Alone", which shall remind the Brothers of the central foundation of their spiritual life and the sole reason for their professional activity.

2°) Promulgation of the Rule:

The Founders gave them a real Rule. "the fundamental part of the current Statutes" as Brother Julien specified. "The reading was carried out in the chapel and the Rule was received as a true gift from heaven."

3°) Taking the religious habit:

The founders gave relevance to the readings and the liturgy, making the taking of the religious habit a great ceremony. In the same spirit of detachment, the Postulants who did not yet have a religious name received it, as was the case with Brother Augustin.

4°) Profession of the vow of Obedience.

The closing of the retreat was marked by a much more important solemnity, such as the religious profession of the vow of Obedience made by those who were considered ready and capable to take it.


Phil. 2: 6 - 11 - Confidence in God the Father

- ⁹ But God raised him high and gave him the name which is above all other names
- 10 so that all beings in the heavens, on earth and in the underworld, should bend the knee[*b] at the name of Jesus

ANTIPHON: Let brotherly love reign among all members of the same community. Let each one feel happy with the joy of the others and suffer with their sorrows, and that all lend themselves, to go to God and fulfill his work, mutual support, (Rule 1825)




Psalm 133 Fraternal Life

Word of God (Lk 4: 17b-19)


- ^{17b} Unrolling the scroll he found the place where it is written:

In the name of the Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, under the protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God.

after having already committed myself *(for ever)* to the imitation of Christ in the way of life by the practice of the evangelical counsels, and in His mission by the Christian education of youth, I pray God to strengthen me in my holy vocation, and declare anew my complete submission to the Rule of Life of the Brothers of Christian Instruction.

Therefore, relying on the bounty of God, freely and voluntarily, I renew my (perpetual) vows of chastity, poverty and obedience, according to the Constitutions of the Congregation and in the spirit which animated our venerable Founders, May God and His holy Mother help me.

Magnificat (Lk 1: 46-55)

ANTIPHON: "Do you want to share the glory of Mary? Imitate her virtues and remember that by her deepest humility she has reached the highest elevation to which a simple creature can aspire." (S II, 439)


Reader 2: We need your help to trust you.

4. **Reader 1:** At Auray the Brothers received their **Being Brothers**, so as to be worried about each other, to support each other and form a united body for mission and in dedication.

Reader 2: We need your help to continue being united.

ALL: Help us, Lord, to be faithful.

5. **Reader 1**: At Auray the Brothers were united in seeking the will of God by **professing obedience** to the superior.

Reader 2: We need your help to continue being faithful.

ALL: Help us, Lord, to be faithful.

6. <u>Reader 1:</u> Today the entire Mennaisian Family is placed in your hands, Lord, we ask you to accompany us, that we will be able to discover your ways so as to be signs of your love, of your affection and to be close to the young people of today, and be concerned for each one.

Reader 2: We need your help, Lord.

ALL: Help us, Lord, to be faithful.

We can freely add other intentions....
