Latest Circular of Br Hervé Zamor, s.g.

« Go and see ! In a Mennaisian Family mode »

« Encouraging to live this invitation of the General Chapter as a call from God for each Lay person and each Brother, here and now» is the heart of the new circular that Br Hervé Zamor, Superior General, just published. It is to discover and to deepen alone, in a team and in community, as a training course.»

The "In Mennaisian Family Mode" is developed in three chapters. The first, to **return to the Source** which plunges us into the heart of our spirituality by making us contemplate the humble, obedient and servant Christ (Phil 2: 5-11). Br Hervé emphasizes welcoming Christ in us, like Mary, «a woman for others». Humility is the source which gives fruitfulness to our apostolate.

The second chapter, **risking the encounter**, urges us to place fraternity at the service of the life of children and young people (Mk 10, 13-16). The latest chapter has invited us to the missionary conversion which prompts us to go out and **dare the peripheries** to serve the poor, those who are far away (Mk 6: 34-44).

Excerpts

• «Go and see!», This is the invitation that the Lord extends today to the entire Mennaisian Family. Responding to this call with generosity and availability will save us from withdrawing into oneself, this evil that kills by asphyxiation. Life belongs to those who dare the outskirts.

• What type of bread does our world need today? If we refer to the biblical letters that make up that term, the bread that Jesus would break in 2021 would be called presence, love, identity and food.

• Breaking bread is the raison d'être of our congregation. Today it is an urgent mission. To meet this missionary challenge, the Brothers and Laity of the Mennaisian Family are invited to lend each other mutual support. As members of the same body, we are called to be mothers, fathers, brothers or sisters, bakers when it comes to meeting the different needs of the children and young people entrusted to us.

Haiti

Haiti earthquake. The Bro. Odile Joseph school is appealing for help to start again

«Haiti goes from trial to trial,» testifies F. Hervé ZAMOR, Superior General, present in Haiti during the events. On Saturday, August 14, at 8:29am, an earthquake struck the southern peninsula of Haiti. More than two thousand dead and thousands more were injured, many houses and public buildings were destroyed or seriously damaged. During the earthquake, the Brothers of 'Les Cayes' were already in Port-au-Prince for the professions of the Brothers.

The 'Frère Odile' College, Les Cayes, and the residence of the Brothers were slightly damaged. The structure of the buildings resisted well, the cracks are only superficial. On the other hand, all the playgrounds, the alleys, the corridors, floors, porches, the fence wall of the land in Bourjolly have to be partially redone. Haiti needs prayer and solidarity to overcome these various trials that it regularly faces.

The Brothers left England. Present for 100 years on British territory, the Brothers have just left. After discerning the realities, **the community of Liverpool** was closed this summer, and the Brothers joined several communities in France. However, they retain the tutelage of **SFX College in Liverpool and Southampton Primary School.** We will have the opportunity to present the history of the century of the Brothers in England in the next issue - now annual - of *La Mennais Magazine*, in No. 48, in December 2021.

The Saint-Jean Baptiste Province. The move from the provincial house of Vannes to the Mother House is nearing completion.

Spain

The Brothers of the **Province of Spain** are doing well and are gradually recovering from the trauma caused by the number of Brothers who died as a direct result of the pandemic. This ordeal showed the support of many people who "love the Mennaisians".

The firm option for the poor and the weakest, with the new project in Zamora, Valladolid, the reception of a new group of refugees in Nanclares, social projects in Mennaisian works... have remained a strong point. A group of Mennaisian lay associates is in the process of discernment.

New everywhere !

France-England

Supervision of schools. The launching of 12 commissions, intended to animate the educational network of the French Mennaisian by the school supervision team, bringing together the 76 schools, took place on September 22. Pedagogy, charisma, school life, spirituality, internationality, finances, sustainable development, solidarity: so many themes that will irrigate the life of the teams serving 35,000 children and young people.

Educational works with the La Mennais Youth. 500 young people took part in more than ten meetings this summer via the Estival Association, with nearly 100 young adult leaders. Projects are also underway with young professionals. An innovation has occurred: the opening of two «Stopovers» to welcome young people and to help with homework and consequently preventing the school drop out in Landerneau and St-Malo.



School principals, staff and volunteers have joined committees.

OCEANIA



Nine Brothers make up the **District of Polynesia.** Although seven Brothers out of nine are retired, all are active with young people, teachers, establishments, and associations: FSCF-Fédération Sportive et Culturelle de France and MEJ-Mouvement Eucharistique des Jeunes. There is also a small community of lay Mennaisians, established in Paea, around educational and leisure activities for children. The first concern of the Brothers is "vocations". Some great young people from the Foyer des Îles, from the FSCF of Paea, from the Agricultural High School of Taiohae... these are the breeding grounds that the District is considering to train Lay Mennaisians and Brothers.

he communities of Kupang, in Indonesia on Flores Island in West Timor and Nanyuki in Kenya, are in the process of being established. Two other communities are open at Zombo and Nebbi in Uganda. *Discovery.*

Kupang – West Timor, Indonesia.

St Joseph Community

Would you know where Kupang (Indonesia) is located ? It is the capital of the region, which includes among others the island of Flores -Larantuka- and the island of Timor. Kupang is located in the westernmost department, with an estimated population of 500,000. It is the 3rd community in Indonesia, after Larantuka and Yogyakarta.

Brothers Adrianus ANDI, Fabianus LAGUR and Philippe BLOT form this new community. Brothers Andi and Faby have begun a cycle of studies: Br Andi in English at the Catholic University and Br Faby at the Catechetical Higher School. Br Philippe will continue his vocational work as well as other services for the mission. The community also aims at welcoming visiting Brothers and give visibility to the Congregation in a university town where many young people from the region come to study. At fifteen minutes from the airport and the Catholic University, the house is located in a quiet area where Catholics, Protestants and Muslims live together.

On June 28, Brothers Andi and Philippe arrived in their new empty house and, that same evening, after having bought two mattresses, slept there. Br Faby joined them a little later. Then began a 4-week setup: purchases and manufacture of furniture by local artisans and the Brothers themselves... The chapel is gradually taking shape and projects are already emerging. The community also found itself a name: Saint Joseph Community, in the year of Saint Joseph, as it was naturally fitting! The Saint Joseph community is counting on the prayers of all...

Br Arsène Pelmoine called out: «Isn't Mr. Querret, by his way of living alongside Jean-Marie de la Mennais, the first 'lay Mennaisian' who availed himself with humility and simplicity for the educational mission?».

Construction Sites

A new High School has been erected !

The entering students of the new St Francis of Assisi High School already started their school year in September and were welcomed in a new building with 6 classrooms on the site of the St Joseph Collège in Savenay, France. In a year, it will be the opening of the High School on a new site. Started in October 2020, work has been progressing well in the Colleraye area. 850 students will be accommodated on the site, which is managed by Pascal Guesdon. The cost is around 20 million euros, funded by a Catholic education in Loire-Atlantique, the Pays de la Loire region and the Ogec of Saint-Joseph College and Notre-Dame School.

This fall is marked by the start of a construction work at the Motherhouse in Ploërmel. Premises on the 1st floor of the building overlooking Boulevard Foch will welcome Brother Provincial, who has left Vannes. Office and meeting rooms will be set up by next February. Premises for the Guardianship service of the La Mennais France educational network - 8 people - will be arranged on 2 levels in the same building, as well as an apartment for the layperson responsible for welcoming at the Motherhouse. They should be operational by September 2022. Finally, a new entrance will be designed in the accommodation building, which will be transformed to contain 30 bedrooms to suit the required standards. The opening is planned for spring 2022.



The work will be barely visible from the outside: it is from the inside that the Mother House of Ploërmel is transformed. This concerns the buildings in a row, on the left in the photo.
