Major superiors and members of the Council were happy to meet at the Casa in Rome





Urging! This is the objective of our Superior General's new circular letter which is primarily intended for the Brothers and also for the laity. It intends to emphasize that «our whole life is formation in response to a call of Christ to conform to him as missionary disciples.» Every day can be «a path that transforms and transfigures our lives.»

According to the account of the disciples of Emmaus (Lk 24:13-35), the Risen One is the One who educates, forms and accompanies. Three chapters punctuate the document: let us walk with Jesus, welcome the Master and start again with Christ every day.



Biodiversity showcases at St. Athanase **High School**

In March, Tahia, Ohana, Manareva, Toho and Damien, 1st grade students of St. Athanase High School in Nuku Hiva, in the Marguesas worked on the layout of an educational tour. It highlighted all the biodiversity present on the High School's farm.

Karl, Yamiley, Aka, Bernard and Alexandre worked hard to maintain our Taunanu: remake the shades of pua uhi (yam), remove the weed from the bins of mint, basil, turmeric, cocoa, medicinal sage ... It was also an opportunity to work in class on self-esteem and emotions.



In this new school year, the Lycée St. Athanase is also opening a first agricultural class (for the Secondary-I group) at the Lycée Saint Joseph de Punauiaa. Agricultural training has become a priority to achieve food self-sufficiency, enhance our natural heritage; we are no longer dependent on the outside world. Next year, another agricultural class for Sec.-II level will be opened.

They apply themselves to learn and act

«I have decided to do everything to acquire skills to practice the job of my choice.» This is the common thread of many young people, especially in the 64 high schools including the 25 vocational schools of the Educational Network La Mennais. Each gesture and each notion tested concretely allow a learning of the realities. One example is the beginning of training in the cultivation and use of artemisia, a natural remedy for malaria. It is implemented at the new St. Joseph Craft Center, in Dungu, Congo DRC.

Spain

They trust in Christ

Throughout his life, Jean-Marie de la Mennais constantly combined trust in God with personal commitment. For him, as for the Brothers, it was a question of doing everything possible and relying on God. He addressed this advice to Brother Ambrose, faced with the many difficulties of the mission of the West Indies: «In all events, however unfortunate they may be, let us never be disturbed to do our best, and then let us remain at peace in the hands of God.» (CG V, December 4, 1845).

The Rule of Life of the Brothers states: Despite his weaknesses and limitations, the Brother moves forward with the «joyful pride of hope», because he knows «in whom he has put his faith».

Let's mention an adventure lately experienced: It was not an easy path! 18 young people and Brothers from Spain and France walked on the Camino de Santiago - from Saint-Jean-Pied-de-Port to Puente la Reina-from 17-23 April.



France

They are formed to serve better

In Lourdes, a formation for the assistants in school pastoral care of the educational networks La Mennais and Merician - Ursulines - of France, lasted four days. At Marie and Bernadette's school, they learned to devote themselves under the sign of service, both to develop their inner resources and to experiment with pedagogical tools offered, aiming at giving better to young people in schools.

100 years in Italy

100 years of the Brothers' presence in Italy! In 1922, the congregation appointed a Procurator, Bro. Philippe Néri, to the Holy See. The Prosecutor lived for a few years with the Marist Fathers. In 1931, the Istituto Sant'Ivo was built in the Monteverde district in **Rome.** The General Procure. residence of the student Brothers, the juniorate and school, cohabited there until the day when the expansion of the school required that it be given all the space. In 1946, the Brothers' students resettled in the Istituto San Giuseppe in Castelgandolfo, in a beautiful property.

That same year, the district of Italy - district Saint-Pierre - was created. In 1962, the 19 Brothers of the District of St. Peter were living into two houses. In 1965, the General Procure and the students moved to the new residence on Via Divina Provvidenza in Rome. Later on, this residence was expanded. After staying on Jersey Island since 1904, the Generalate House was then transferred in Rome in 1972 and has accommodated the General Administration since then.

After the recent transfer of the property of the Istituto San Giuseppe, a former juniorate, which later became a community residence and reception center - Casa Mennesiana- in Castelgandolfo, the closure of the Sant'Ivo primary school in Rome took place last June. At present, all the Brothers present in Italy are grouped in the Generalate House into two communities and attached to the General Administration.

Providence has many surprises in store for us! » This is the symbolic echo heard during the General Chapter of the Sisters of Providence of Saint-Brieuc which has just been lived from May 3rd-13th on the Ile Blanche, in Locquirec, Finistère, France.

A new General Council has been elected: Sister Louise **TOUCHETTE** is the new Superior General, assisted by two councilors, Sister Huguette PROVOST and Sister Anne-Marie FREARSON.

In particular, the request for the integration of young women from Nebbi, Uganda into the Congregation, was received positively. Placed under the sign of this sentence of the Acts of the Apostles (11:23) - «In this world that God loves, seeing God's grace at work, (Paul) was glad» -, the 14 Capitulant Sisters lived this Chapter with the help of Bro. Yannick Houssay, Apostolic Assistant of the Congregation.



313 letters exchanged with Fr. de la Mennais! In office at the age of 21, from 1822 to 1872, at the St-Nicolas school in Quintin - not far from St-Brieuc - Brother Laurent Haudry is the subject of the issue of "Recherches historiques" which has just been published. Stories of daily life, pedagogical approach, advice to deal with harassment of all kinds, over the 50 years, under the pen of Bro. Claude Launay, the reader attaches himself to the ideal example of this Brother who devoted himself entirely to the work entrusted.

Trained at the novitiate of Auray held by Fr. Gabriel Deshayes, Bro. Laurent was assigned in Quintin by Fr. de la Mennais. Faced with poverty in the region, following the decline of the linen trade, it was necessary to adapt, open a boarding school, expand, offer new courses. We also see how the Founder relied on the establishment of the Brothers who were responsible for the coordination of a geographical sector, piloting the organization and its development. Following the merger with the Collège-Lycée Jean XXIII in recent years, the history of the school ends with its closure in the summer of 2019. In the end, a stimulant issue to discover without waiting!
